These guidelines apply only to applicants who **are not nationals of the UK or European Economic Area (EEA)**, to be compatible with UK right to work guidelines. - The ID check part of the DBS process is not the actual DBS application: you have to complete this online separately to the ID check.

• <u>CHANGES OF NAME</u>: please provide documents in your current name only. If you have **changed your name** since birth, do not choose your birth certificate or anything else showing a previous name. If you *have* to use such a document, you must also provide your marriage certificate or change of name deed as evidence of the name change, but we are **NOT able to accept a driving licence in a previous name** (even with evidence of the change) so you cannot use this.

• UNABLE TO PROVIDE SUFFICIENT DOCUMENTS?

If you cannot provide the documentation required, we will be unable to submit a DBS check application for you. You must be able to provide the required documentation when you register on course, at the latest. If you cannot do so, you will not be able to start your proposed course.
