- A. Using information gathered from interviewing someone of a different generation to yourself, analyse how your chosen issue has changed over time (approx. 750 words) and consider how what you have leant might impact on your professional practice (approx. 250 words). (LO2)
- B. With reference to a film selected from the reading list, show how an understanding of culture, subculture and deviance helps you reflect on what the film conveys in relation to your chosen issue (1000 words) (LO1)
- C. With reference to your chosen news story/ documentary, compare and assess the cultural differences experienced by children, young

people, families and communities in relation to your chosen issue. (1000 words) (LO3)
