Details and Criteria:

This assignment will enable you to understand the importance of stakeholder management to effectively communicate with project team members, project sponsors, project boards and wider stakeholders.

The word limit for this assignment is the equivalent of 3,000 words.

Intended Learning Outcomes (ILOs)

- 1. Explain the concepts and practice of stakeholder management
- 2. Explain the key contents and purpose of the communication plan
- 3. Explain the concepts of conflict and conflict management
- 4. Describe common conflict management methods, for example, negotiation

Task Description

Scenario

Barrow Town Football Club and Furness Giants Rugby Club recently encountered objections to a proposed shared multi-purpose sports stadium planned to be developed on the outskirts of the town, as a result, this project was terminated.

The investors have now decided to re-develop one of the clubs' existing stadium and have appointed you as the new Project Manager.

To prevent a repeat of the resistance from some of the stakeholder's that hindered the initiation phase of the first project, the Project Manager will have to implement effective stakeholder, communication and possibly conflict management strategies. Effective stakeholder management

is a core project management skill and activity that is essential to maximise the chances of project success, therefore, the project manager must demonstrate these competencies.

In the form of a written report...

Task 1

- Explain the concepts and practice of stakeholder management in Project Management.
- In the form of a table with justification, identify the potential stakeholders for the stadium project.
- Analyse these stakeholders to produce a 'Power and Interest' chart to map their potential influences on the project.

Task 2

- Explain the key contents and purpose of a project communication plan.
- Within the context of the scenario, produce a project communication plan as an example.

Task 3

Explain the concepts of conflict and conflict management, discussing types of conflict, how conflict might occur on a project and its potential consequences.

Task 4

- Describe a common conflict management method, for example, negotiation.
- Choose one of the stakeholder groups identified during your stakeholder management process that may be strongly opposed to development. Describe a conflict management approach you could adopt to appreciate their point of view in the hope to reduce resistance, conflict, and increasing their chances of supporting the project.
- N.B. You must support your work with references to academic sources.
