Details and Criteria:

This assignment requires you to write a first-person reflective report that makes use of the portfolio that you have developed for Assignment 1, and then considers this in the context of your career and your professional development. You are encouraged to use one or more formal reflective practice techniques in this assignment, Kolb or Gibbs for example.

Your work should be written as a report and therefore should contain an introduction, a main body and a conclusion (all 3 of which will contribute to the word count).

In the main body of your report you should address topics such as:

- What are my aims and objectives for the short to mid-term future (next 1-3 years)? How have these been derived? Are they reasonable?
- What is my expected career path (3 10 yrs)? Why is this appropriate? Is it realistic?
- Am I making appropriate progress?
 - If not, why not, what actions should I take as a result?
 - If so, then what can be done to get even more value out of the experiences / opportunities that are being encountered?

- 3. Capture evidence from a variety of sources and evaluate your professional development.
- 4. Evaluate personal progress towards clearly identifiable targets.
