**Details and Criteria:**

This written assignment will take the form of an article for Horizons, a magazine for outdoor educators, professionals and practitioners published by the Institute for Outdoor Learning.

Select an outdoor education context experienced within the module, such as place-based, expedition-based or environmental contexts and comment on its relevance within contemporary outdoor learning. Draw from your first-hand experience of your chosen approach and reflect on that experience to suggest best practice and ideas; what happened, what did you learn, how might it be of benefit to the wider outdoor community?

This is both a theoretical piece of writing that critiques the nature of activity in contemporary outdoor learning from a review of relevant literature and current social thinking, and it is also a 'practice paper' which suggests possible ways that your theoretical understanding could be put into practice by the wider educational community, helping to inform the future learning experiences of others in the outdoors and promoting a 'learning profession'.

Many academics publish in Horizons, as the best way to communicate with the practitioners and translate research into informing changes in working practice.

*Checklist for Submitting an article*

- Ask a colleague or friend to look over your article and tell you if it reads smoothly, is not too long-winded and fits the reflective practice/professional ethos above.
- Include an author biography of up to 100 words and an author photo.
- An article needs to be formatted as a Horizons Article (Exemplar on Blackboard) with photos/images/diagrams/tables titled, referenced and placed within the text (if relevant).

If in your original submission you didn't achieve the pass mark, you can make alterations to the original submission and resubmit that. **Please highlight all changes and additions though using a highlighter.**
