Title: 'A critical and systematic study of an aspect of practice relevant to your professional setting'

In the summative submission you will need to divide your work into two sections, a written rationale/outline and a portfolio of outcomes/analysis/discussion/conclusions.

Both sections will be marked separately and your overall mark will be the aggregate of the two marks. This means that one of the sections could receive a 'fail' mark but you would still pass the module as long as the overall aggregate mark is 50% or over. It is also important to note, therefore, that you must clearly delineate the two sections of your work in the final submission.

The first section of the summative assignment can make use of your formative work (you can reuse as much of this as you wish), and will outline the rationale for your work, providing an overview, references to key literature and theories/frameworks as relevant. You should also briefly refer to ethical issues here (as relevant) and also any theoretical/research approaches as needed.

The second section is called the portfolio, and you can be as flexible/imaginative with this as you wish. Consider the use of diagrams, graphics, tables and visuals and so on, as well as the use of sub headings where relevant. Please discuss with me if you need further advice. This longer section should present your results/conclusions/analysis/discussion as relevant and refer back to key literature/theories and frameworks as necessary. Please note that your portfolio allows you to submit in different formats but they need to be compiled into one document for submission. Whatever formats you choose - content should be underpinned with academic rigour and referenced.

Conclusions or final thoughts should be kept within the context of your work/experiences. You can also refer to future work or directions you might take, as the work for this module is often exploratory work/reading with future, broader research in mind.

Please note that the final reference list is not included in the word count, and neither would any tables or diagrams used in the text.
