Task:

Chose three of the guest speaker sessions that you have participated in during this module.

For each quest speaker:

- Briefly describe the role of the professional you may need to use a website associated with the profession to obtain a role description. (DO NOT use a careers/job agency website for this information as it will negatively impact when your summative assessment is graded). Cite the source/s you have used.
- 2. **Identify the community group that the professional supports** Which community group did the professional discuss? What issues/challenges does this community group face? Why does this community group require professional support? Cite the sources you have used.
- 3. Use social theory to explain how the professionals interact with the community group to support and meet their needs What social theory could be applied? How does this theory explain the professional response and/or professional

understanding as to why this social issue occurs? (Remember to go back to the social theory folder if you need a re-cap on suggested types of social theories). Cite the sources you have used. **NOTE:** For each guest speaker there must be a different social theory used. Therefore, once the assessment is completed, there will be a minimum of three different social theories applied. Each guest speaker write-up should be approximately 500 words. Use the remaining 250 words towards the introduction and conclusion. Your conclusion **must** summarises the findings of the three chosen quest speakers by identifying key points from each that address ILO2 and 3.
