

Eduroam Setup – Android Quick Guide

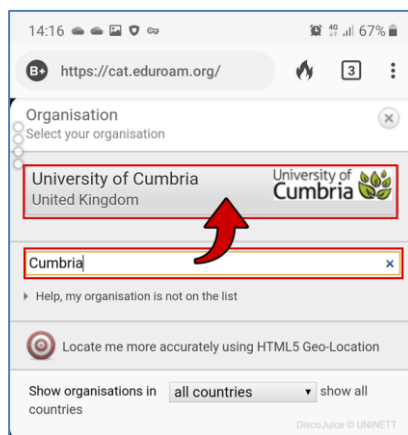
This Quick Guide shows you how to setup your Android device to use the [Eduroam](https://www.eduroam.org/) wi-fi network.

In order to configure Eduroam for an Android phone or tablet, you will need to **download and install the EduroamCat App from the Google Play store** (or Amazon App store for Kindle tablets):

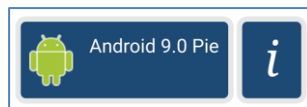

1. With the App installed – you now need to visit cat.eduroam.org in your mobile/tablet web browser to download a configuration file that will allow you to create your profile and sign into Eduroam:

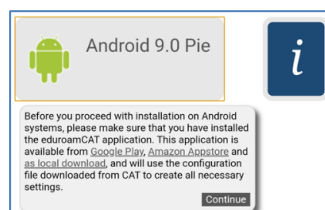
- a. When you land at cat.eduroam.org, you will be prompted to **select your organisation**. If you have “location” switched on, on your device, it will pick up all of the possible organisations near you. Otherwise you will need to search for Cumbria in the search box:



- b. Eduroam will now automatically detect which version of Android you are using and offer you the correct configuration file for your device:

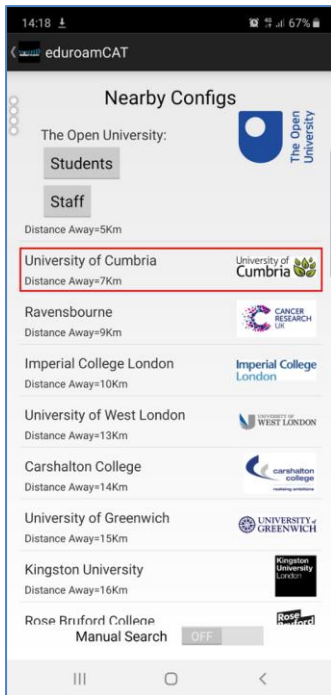


- c. When you click on this button, Eduroam will prompt you to have the Eduroam Android App installed before you continue. If you grabbed the App first, you can click on **Continue** and wait for the download to finish:

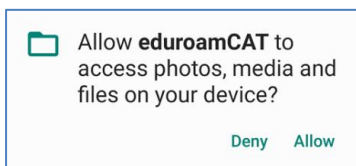


- d. You do not need to do anything with the download file – the Eduroam App will pick this up and configure your connection with it.

2. Open the Eduroam CAT App and select the University of Cumbria (if it does not appear in the list on your screen – select “Manual Search” and search for Cumbria):



3. You will see a popup permissions window that is asking to allow Eduroam to access files on your device. **This is needed** so that the App can read the newly downloaded configuration file. Click **Allow**:

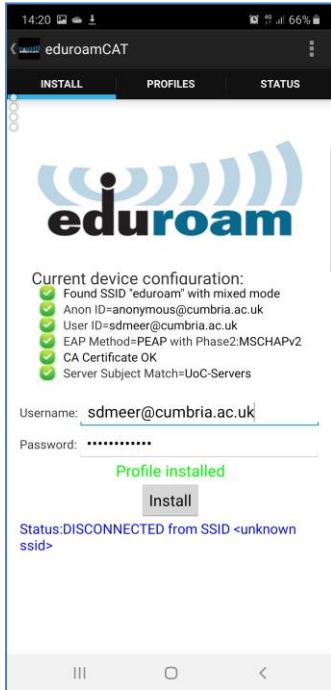


4. You will now see the Configuration File on your screen – click **Install** to add this file to the Eduroam App:



5. You are now asked to **add your university login** credentials to the configuration installation and then hit the **Install** button. For Eduroam – **your login is:**

- **Students** – studentnumber + @cumbria.ac.uk (e.g. **1234567@cumbria.ac.uk**)
- **Staff** – networkname + @cumbria.ac.uk (e.g. **asmith@cumbria.ac.uk** or **andy.smith@cumbria.ac.uk**)



Eduroam is now ready to use.

Go to the wifi settings on your device and select Eduroam from the list of available networks.

If you have the option – select Connect Automatically – this will connect you to Eduroam whenever you are in range of an Eduroam hotspot.
