

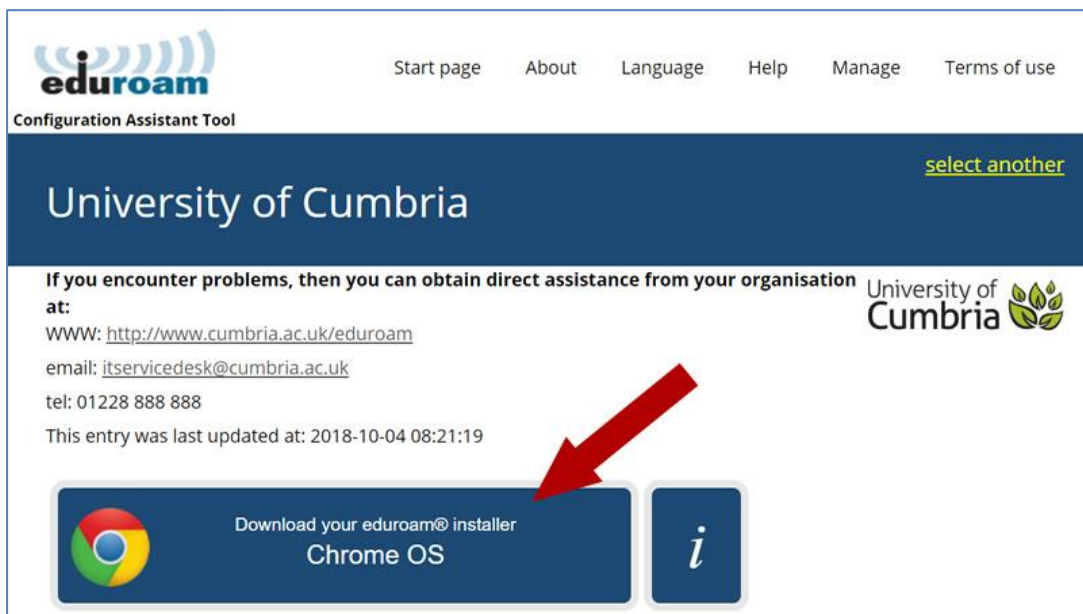
Eduroam Setup – Chromebook Quick Guide

This Quick Guide shows you how to setup your Chromebook or Chromium Tablet to use the [Eduroam](#) wi-fi network.

In order to configure Eduroam for Chrome Device, you will need to **visit the Eduroam website to download and install the Eduroam configuration file:**

1. When you arrive at Eduroam on your Chromebook (or tablet), you are prompted to download the installer. **Click** on the button to begin:

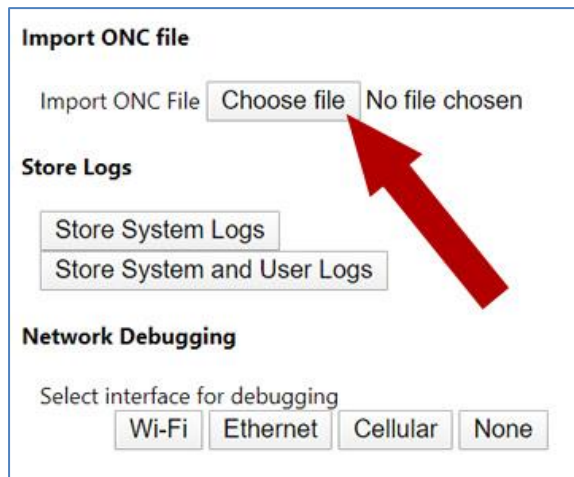


2. When you click on the button, you are given an extra piece of information about how to install the downloaded file. You can ignore this, as we are covering the steps in this guide. Click on Continue to proceed:



3. This process has downloaded an **.onc** configuration file for your device and this now needs to be imported into your Chromebook settings.

In the web browser – go to **chrome://net-internals/#chromeos** and select **Choose File** next to **“Import ONC File”**.



4. You may need to browse to your Downloads folder to find the ONC file, but most Chromebooks will automatically discover the file and will then install it silently in the background.

Eduroam is now ready to use.

Go to the wifi settings on your device and select Eduroam from the list of available networks.

If you have the option – select Connect Automatically – this will connect you to Eduroam whenever you are in range of an Eduroam hotspot.
