

# Wi-fi and printing information

There are two Wi-Fi networks on campus that you can access on your own device; **UoC-Visitor** and **Eduroam**.

**UoC-Visitor** is only accessible at the University of Cumbria, you will need to log in with your student number and password.



**Eduroam** can be used at all educational establishments that subscribe to it, you need to configure your device first before you can connect to this network

## How do I connect to **Eduroam**?

- Select **UoC-Visitor** network
- Enter your user credentials - your student number and password
- Click connect
- You will now be connected to the Wi-Fi on campus
- Open a web browser and type in **www.cumbria.ac.uk/eduroam**
- Follow the instructions to download the configuration tool. You will then be able to automatically connect to Eduroam on campus and at other institutions that use it.

You log into Eduroam with Username: your network username@**cumbria.ac.uk** e.g. for students: **123456@cumbria.ac.uk** (no S at the beginning)
