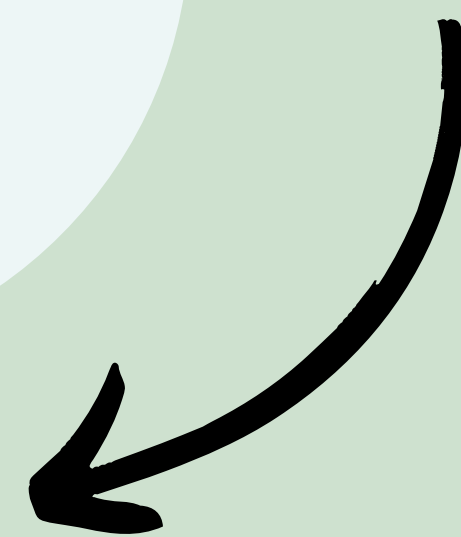

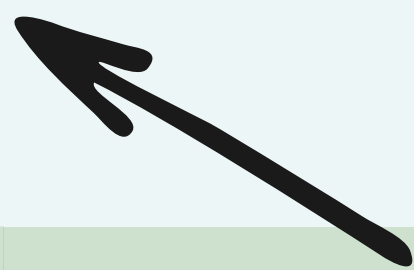
Welcome to the London Campus! Let's go and visit the library.

This is the main entrance to the campus.



These are the doors that lead to the reception (left photo) and classrooms (right photo).

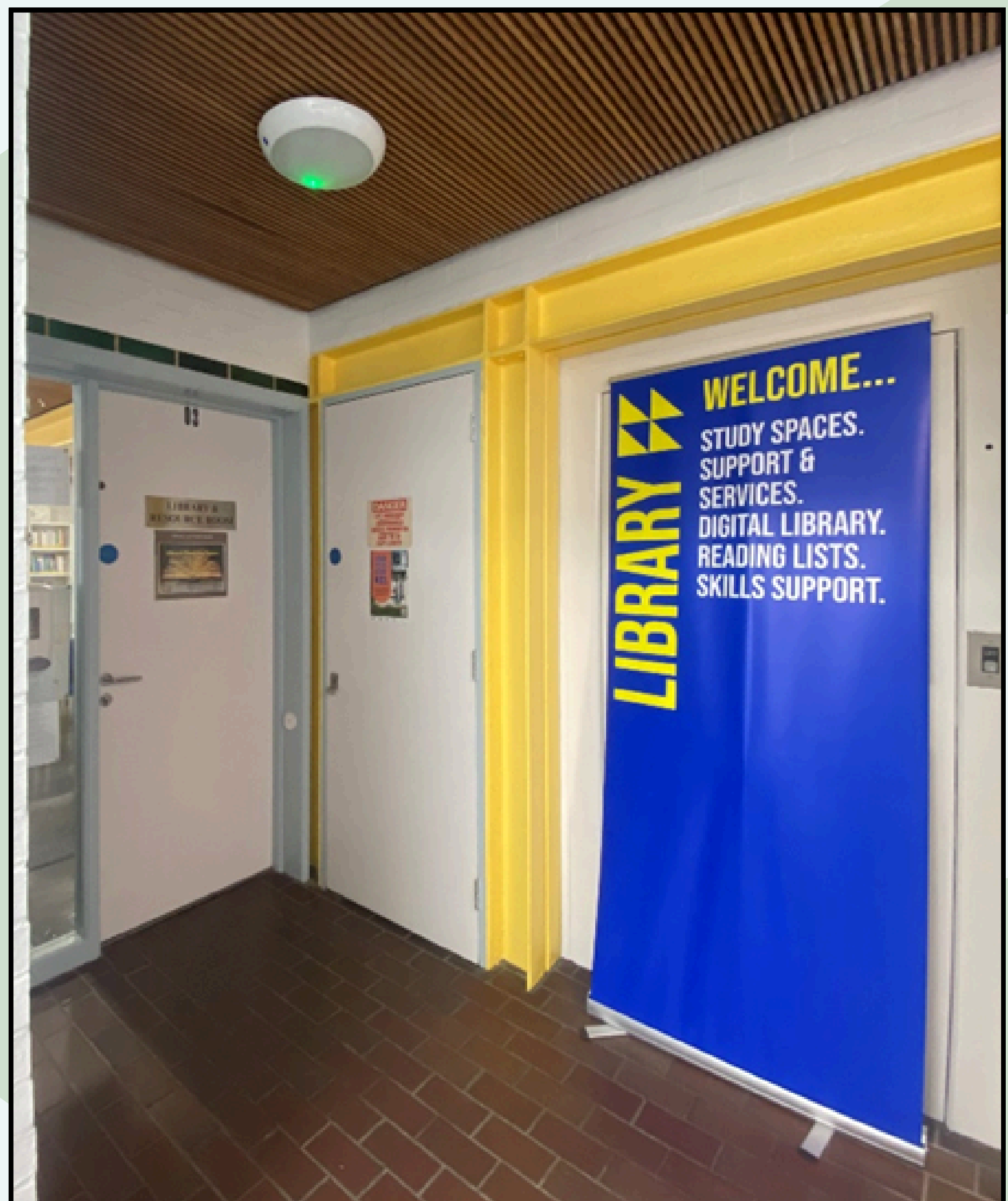
Once you've entered the reception door using your Cumbria card, you'll see our front desk where you can get support with questions or ask to speak with Student Services staff. There is a scanner/printer available here for staff and students to use.



Turn left to find the corridor that leads to the London Campus library.



Follow the corridor to the end and turn left to reach the library entrance.

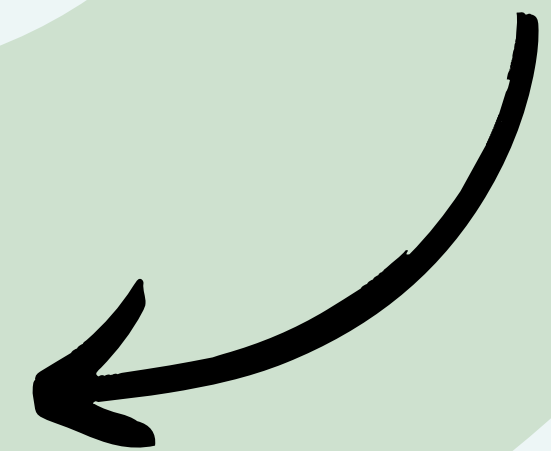
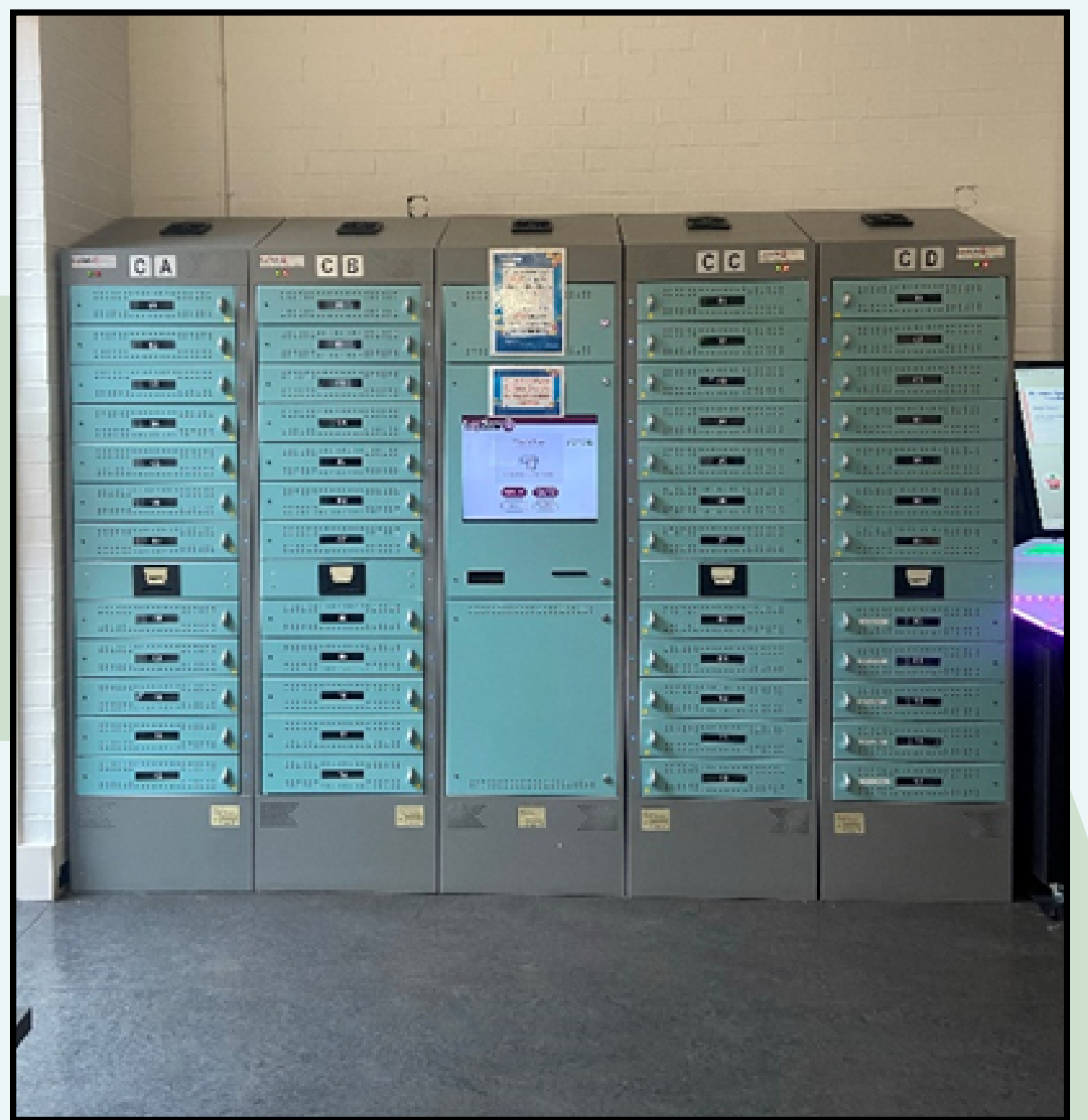


When you enter the library you will see a quiet study area, the library book collection, a self service kiosk and lockers with laptops for you to borrow. A campus assistant will be available to help you during staffed hours.



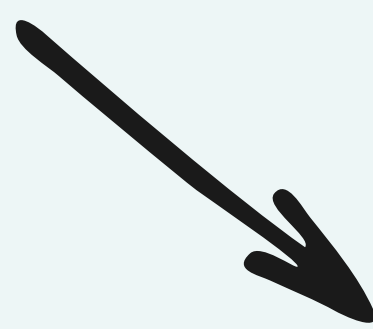
To your left, you will see the printer/photocopier, laminator, desktop computers, and screen displays to connect your laptop to.

You will need your Cumbria card and library PIN to borrow a laptop from the lockers.



Near to the library desk there is a collection of children's books for reference.

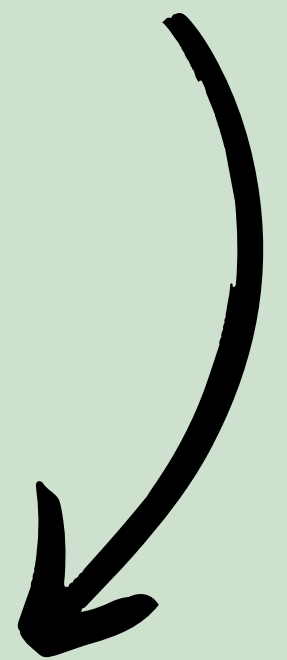
The reading for pleasure books are on shelves next to the library desk.



Behind the library desk is the reservation shelf. You can collect books that you have requested from here and borrow them using the self service kiosk.

You can browse the library catalogue on the tablet below the reservation shelf.

One of the doors from the library leads to the Campus Faith Room.



Back in the reception, if you turn left and walk past the vending machine, you'll find some classrooms. When these aren't being used for classes, you can use them as study spaces. You can also see the coffee machine to the right, and the door to the café, cabin, and outdoor seating area on the left.

After exiting the door to the outdoors area, you will see seating on the right.

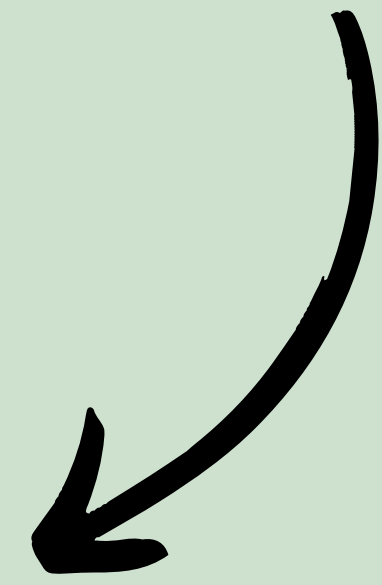


You will then see the campus café on the left where you can get food and drink, socialise, or study in a casual environment.

Next door to the café is the cabin, another casual area with chairs, sofas, board games, a ping pong table, a TV, and more.



Opposite the reception entrance is this doorway that leads to the classrooms on the left, and toilets on the right.



When not in use for teaching, you can use classrooms for quiet or group study. Check the doors for room timetables to find out when they are free.
