

Exporting from Sage to Refworks

To export individual articles

- open the article and Click on the **Cite article** icon
- Scroll to the **OR Download to Reference Manager** and select RefWorks from the dropdown.



OR

Download to reference manager

If you have citation software installed, you can download article citation data to the citation manager of your choice

Select your citation manager software:

Direct import


DOWNLOAD CITATION

Make sure Direct import is ticked and it will pull the reference straight into RefWorks.

Exporting multiple articles is a two-step process. Export the references to your Downloads and then Import into RefWorks.

- Tick the articles and click on **Export selected articles**.

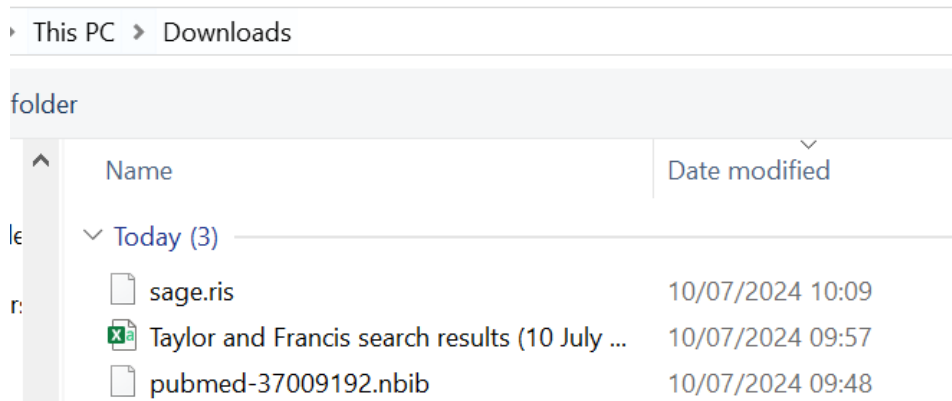

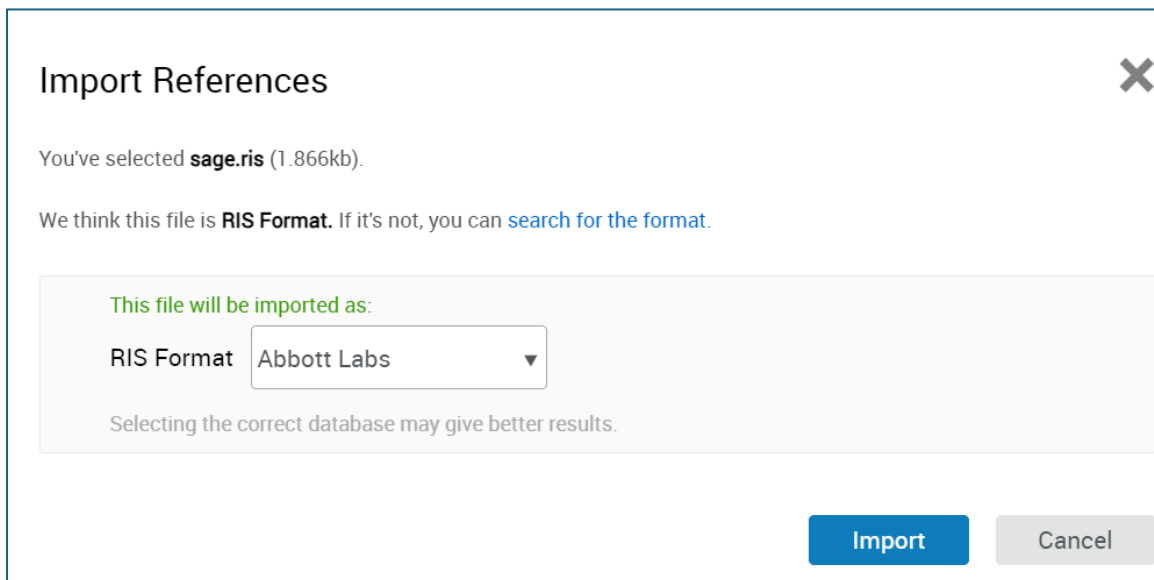
