## **Exporting single articles**

• Open the article and Click on the *Cite this article* (part of the title details)



• Select Download citation and select RefWorks

Download a citation file in RIS format that can be imported by citation management software including EndNote, ProCite, RefWorks and Reference Manager.
Choose format: ORIS OBibTex <b>O</b> RefWorks Direct Export
Choose options: OCitation OCitation & abstract OCitation & references

## **Exporting multiple citations**

First tick the articles you want and the click on the *"Download citation* link at the top of the results (below the tabs).



- It then creates a Download file
- Select RefWorks direct export and Download

TIP – Ignore the big green export search results button – it doesn't work.

It doesn't open RefWorks in a new tab, it just overwrites the Taylor and Francis screen, so save your search to get back to.
