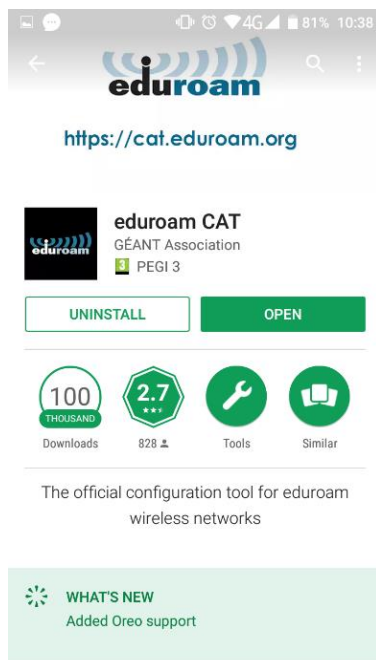


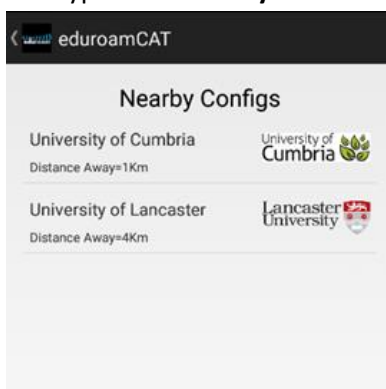
Connecting to Eduroam on an Android, Apple & Amazon device.

Make sure that you are either signed into UoC-Visitor or using your mobile network first to get internet access before continuing.

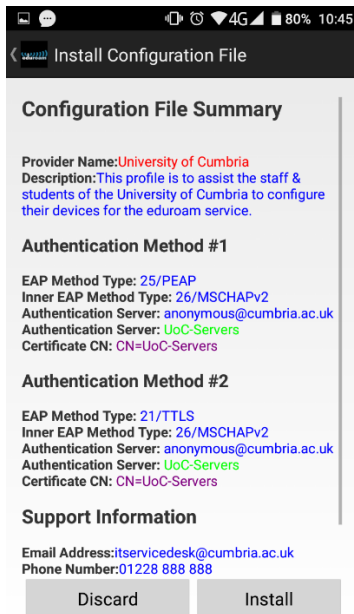
1. Sign into the [Google Play Store](#) / Apple App Store / [Amazon Tablet App Store](#) with your own personal account.
2. Once signed in, in the search box type Eduroam CAT. Tap on the first result in the list.
3. To confirm that this is the correct application, ensure that the developer name is GEANT Association.



4. Tap on **'Install'** and wait for the app to install to your device.
5. Open the app. When it is first launched you will be met with a list of Nearby Configs. If there is nothing in this list after a few moments, tap on Manual Search at the bottom of the app and type in **University of Cumbria**, then tap Search.

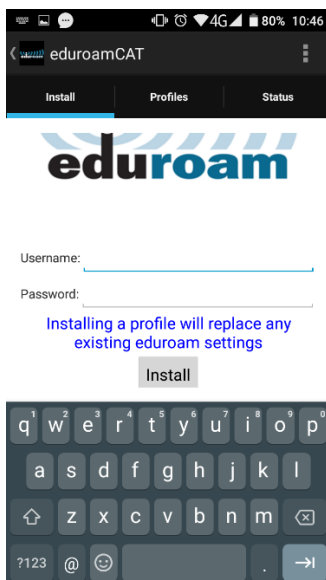


6. Tap on the **University of Cumbria** listing and then tap **Install**. Tap **yes** on the confirmation pop up.



7. Once the configuration file has been installed you will be met with a login screen. Type in your username (**yournetworkusername@cumbria.ac.uk**) and password, then tap Install.

(Please note: your username looks just like an email address, but it isn't. This means that a student username for Eduroam will look like **0123456@cumbria.ac.uk** and a staff username will look like **firstname.lastname@cumbria.ac.uk**)



8. You will be met with a **Profile Installed** message highlighted in green and your WiFi should now have automatically connected itself to the Eduroam network. To test that you're now connected to Eduroam, go to your phone settings > WiFi and confirm that it is on Eduroam.
